Dear Parents/Guardians,

The Cape May Point Beach Patrol is proud to continue to offer The Junior Lifeguard Program for the 2018 season. Much appreciation is extended for your continued support. Funding for the program is provided primarily through fees and private donations.

The program will run Wednesday, **July 3rd to July 27th 2018**. During these four-weeks, the program meets three days a week (Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday) for two hours each day (10am-12pm). In addition to the daily educational aspect of the program, we intend to hold a car wash, an end of the year pizza party, beach tag design contest, competitions, and Mascot Races. Rain date make-ups will be determined as the situation arises and at the discretion of the chief.

In order to accommodate the needs of each child, we separate The Juniors into three main age groups; which include ages: (A) 13-15, (B) 10-12 and (C) 7-9. The registration fee provides each participant with a uniform, which includes a pair of shorts and an official CMPBP Jr. Lifeguard tee shirt, plus membership in the United State Lifesaving Association. Additional uniforms may be purchased for **\$40** while supplies last.

New this year is the chance to pay all fees upfront in one payment/check for any optional add-ons (competitions, official Jr. sweatshirt, extra uniform). Our registration fees are as follows:

- **\$110** per child for the full four weeks. If you have more than one child participating in the full program, the first child is **\$110** and each additional child is **\$75**.
- **\$75** per child for those who will only be in the program for two weeks. (*If your children plan to remain in the program for longer than two weeks, this option does not apply.*)
 - o This fee covers the uniforms for each child, instruction from trained lifeguards plus necessary safety equipment and materials needed throughout the program.
- **\$25** per child if you want your child/children to compete in the Junior USLA Championship. Fee includes race fee.

Please make checks payable to: *The Borough of Cape May Point*. Additionally, our beach patrol offices are not open until June; please send registration and payment after May 1, 2018.

Cape May Point Junior Lifeguard Camp Code of Conduct Agreement 2018

In order for the Cape May Point Junior Lifeguard to be fun and safe, there needs to be rules. It is each Junior's responsibility to follow the policies listed below. Please review them with your child and sign the bottom of the form.

- Follow instructor's directions at all times.
- Give turns and share with others.
- Be a friend and include all others regardless of race, religion or sex.
- Solve problems positively.
- Keep hands and feet to yourself at all times.
- Use polite words in an appropriate voice.
- Respect and take care of all property and equipment.
- Care for and encourage one another.
- Clean and keep beach clean, especially plastic water bottles.
- Accept consequences from the instructors and/or officers of the CMPBP.
- No cell phones or other electronic devices; keep in bag or backpack.
- *There is a zero tolerance policy for hitting and bullying!*
- *There is a zero tolerance policy for stealing!*
- *There is a zero policy for disrespecting staff!*

There is a zero policy for discriminatory, sexual, political or drug related comments to the staff or other junior guards!

The above rules are necessary for the program to be a positive environment for all. The rules are in place to insure that everyone has a good time and remains safe. If a junior guard has trouble following the rules stated above, he/she will be referred immediately to Ben Swan who is the director of the program. Ben and/or Chief Bill have the right to suspend a junior guard for disrespectful behavior and breaking the Code of Conduct Agreement. No refunds will be given.

1. 1st minor infraction: verbal reprimand
2. 2nd minor infraction: documentation in file
3. 3rd minor infraction: Discussion with guard and parent. Possible removal from program.

All major infractions (in italicized type): a meeting with a parent and immediate dismissal.
