## Surf Chair Sign Out

For your convenience, a surf chair has been donated in order to afford safe beach access for elderly, handicapped, or impaired beach patrons. It can be reserved through the Cape May Point Beach Patrol Captain. Beach access is limited to Coral and Alexander Avenues and is the sole responsibility of the patrons themselves. Please observe the following rules and sign the proper waiver form upon application for use. Enjoy the beach!

### Rules and Regulations

1. Do not place chair in more than six inches of water or the chair may tip over.
2. Do not leave the chair in the water, without attendant, while someone is sitting in it.
3. Do not leave anyone unattended near road while unattended, as the chair can be self-propelled.
4. Do not use this chair on streets, roads, or sidewalks.
5. Do not use this chair on steps, or steep slopes.
6. It is advisable to remove footrest through transfer process.
7. Engage wheel locks through the transfer process.
